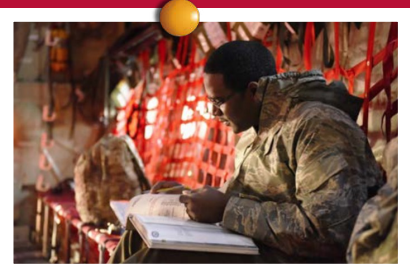

## Purpose:

Troops to Teachers was established in 1994 to assist transitioning Service members and veterans in beginning new careers in public, charter, and Bureau of Indian Affairs schools.

The Department of Defense program facilitates veterans' successful transition to a teaching career by providing counseling, financial and placement assistance for eligible Service members and veterans.

## Eligibility:

All current and former members of the U.S. Armed Forces may participate in the program for counseling, referral services and employment assistance.

## Financial Aid:

Those who meet certain education, military service and application requirements may also be eligible for TTT financial assistance of up to 10K to support their transition to the classroom.

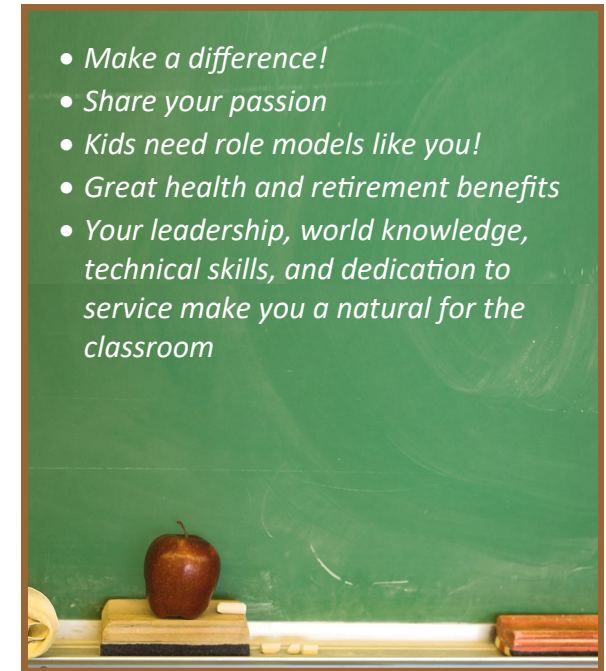
### **Expand Your Career Options by Planning for Your Future**
