



Teaching in Wisconsin



Teacher Licensure

- A Bachelor's degree is required for most Wisconsin teaching licenses.
- Attend an accredited and approved Teacher Education Program (TEP)
- If out-of-state, has comparable degree and teaching major/minor requirements to those prescribed by Wisconsin Administrative Code PI 34 and is equivalent in content and scope to approved programs offered by Wisconsin institutions.
- Verification of completed TEP requirements via an Institutional Recommendation
- Completion of Teaching Methods
- Completion of Student Teaching
- Completion of the PRAXIS Core Tests and PRAXIS Subject Area Tests
