**SUBJECT: 2011 County Veterans' Service Grant**

The application packet for the 2011 County Veterans' Service Grant, WDVA 0055, is now available online at [www.WisVets.com/Forms/#WDVA0055](http://www.WisVets.com/Forms/#WDVA0055). Page 4 of the application (WDVA 0055D) dealing with federal benefits has been revised in the interests of clarity following a review by the County Veterans Service Officer (CVSO) Association's Executive Committee.

Note: Wisconsin Administrative Code, VA 8.02 (3), requires that a certified copy of the budget adopted by the county board for county veterans service office operation for the fiscal year for which the grant is claimed be submitted with the application. This can be a signed statement by the CVSO, his/her designee, county clerk/treasurer or other county official, certifying that the submitted budget is true and correct.

A letter announcing the availability of the CVSO Grant is also being sent to the County Administrators/Executives of each of the 72 counties. Applications for the grant should be sent to the following address:
